Russ Pulliam directs a summer internship program for The Indianapolis Star and Arizona Republic, is a columnist for Indy Star and reports as a free-lancer for several news outlets.

A graduate of Williams College, he has been a reporter for the Associated Press in New York City and the Washington Post. He also was a college correspondent for The New York Times, the Springfield Union and Berkshire Eagle.
